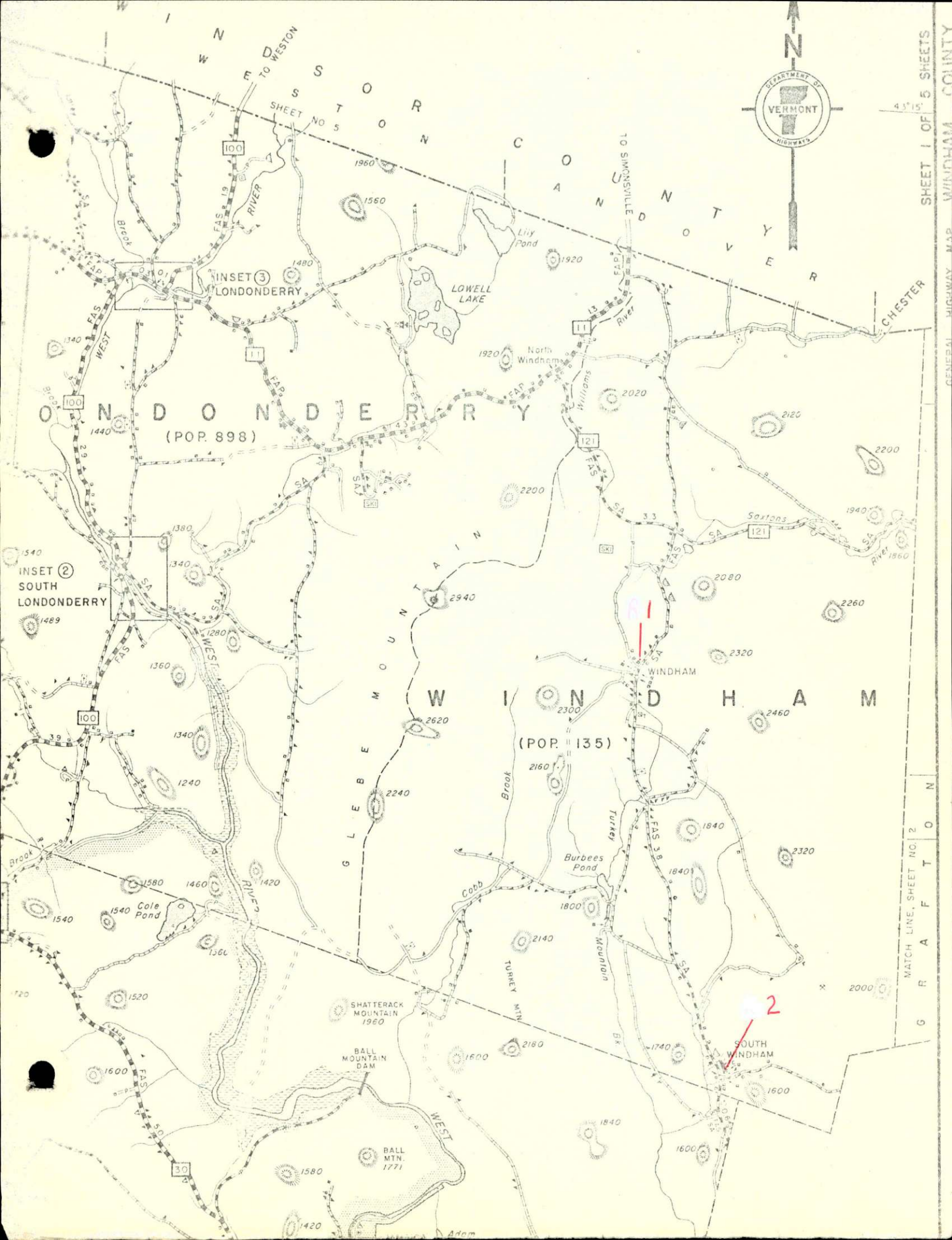

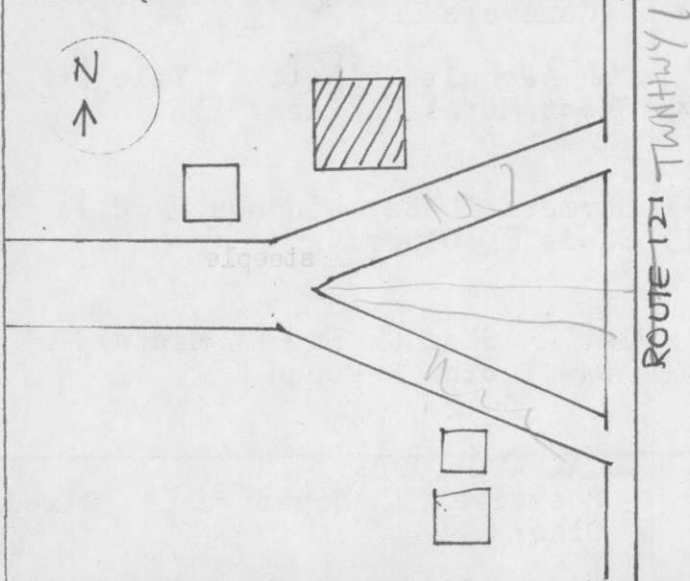
Open wooden porch without roof across front. 3-tier steeple; 1st and 2nd tiers square, 3rd tier is spire.

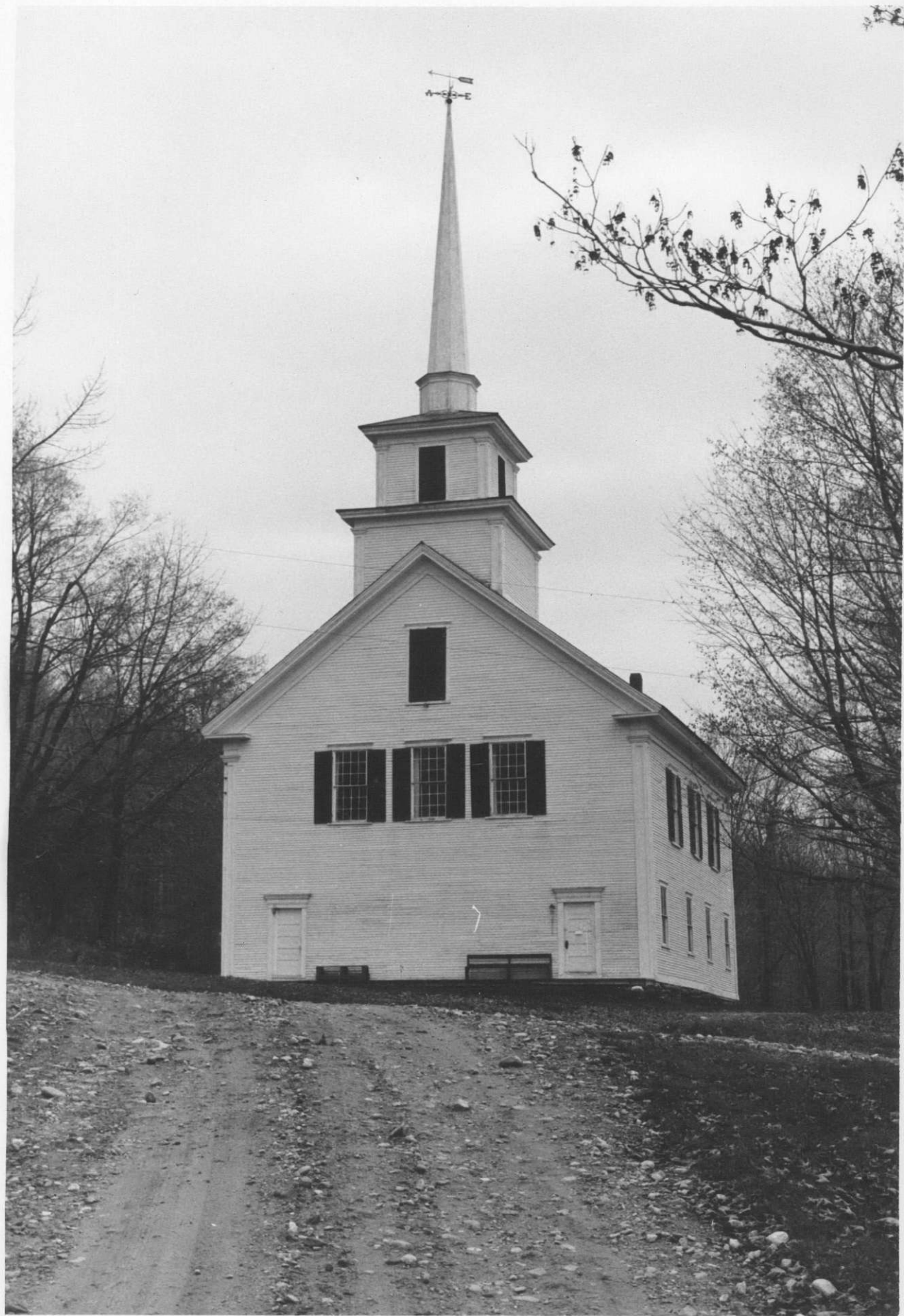

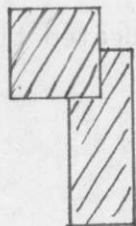

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

Church represents an interesting variation on the vernacular Greek Revival theme through the use of both brick and clapboard. The recessed arcaded wall treatment is found in various domestic building types throughout Eastern Vermont as far North as Chester between the years 1814 and 1830.

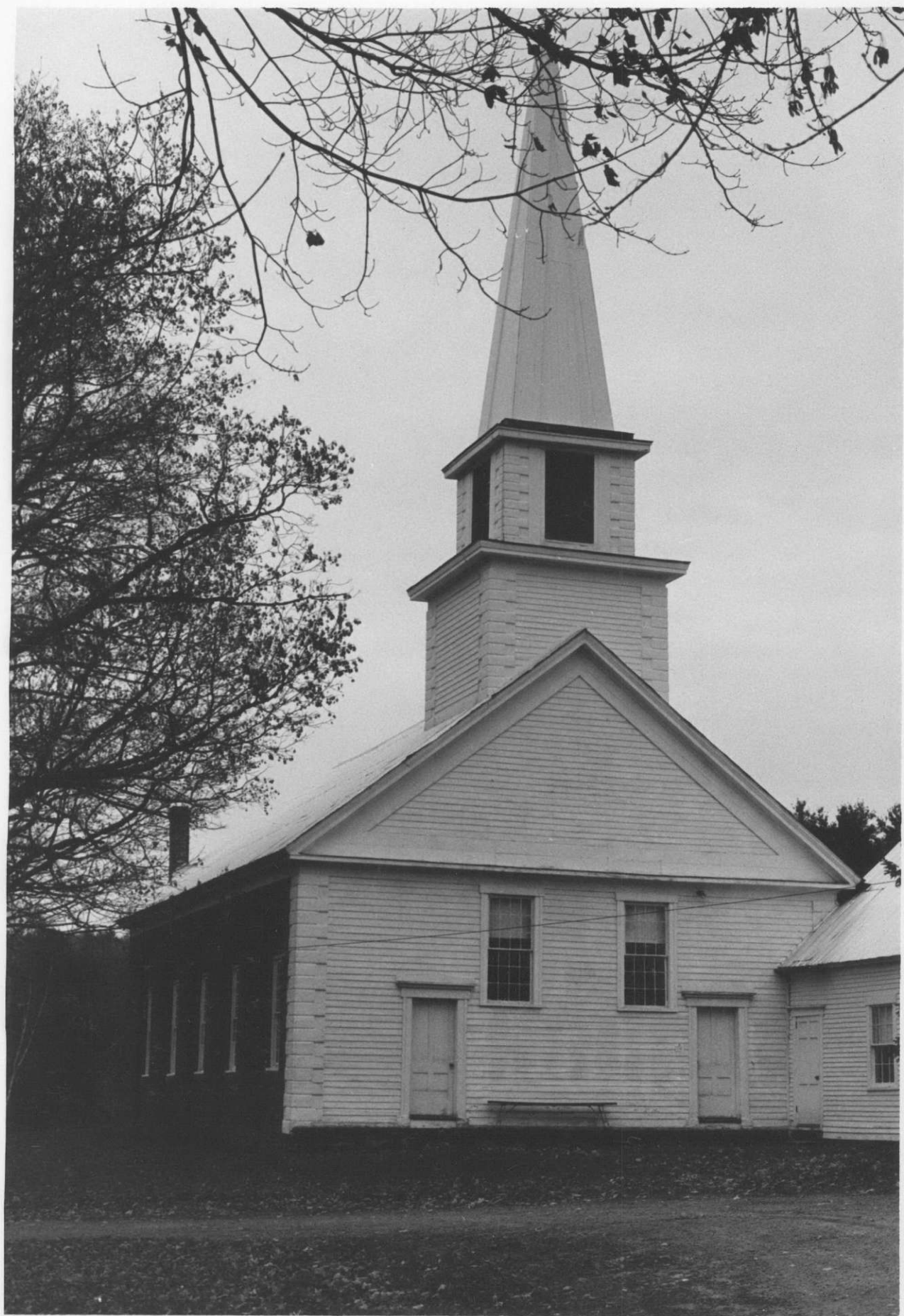
