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1.0 Summary of Response Actions

Environmental Products & Services of Vermont, Inc. (EPSVT) hereby presents this spill summary report detailing emergency spill response activities related to the release of an unknown quantity of diesel fuel from a Windham Town Garage (WTG) owned diesel fuel aboveground storage tank (AST) at the WTG located at 6626 Windham Hill Road in Windham, Vermont (Figure 1).

The release occurred on March 9, 2018 and was later discovered on March 10/11, 2018. The spill was reported to the VTDEC on March 20, 2018. The release occurred when a Windham Town school bus was filling up with diesel at the facility. The driver of the bus reportedly set the dispenser handle on automatic and walked away from the bus during the fill up. At some point while he was gone, the pump began dispensing diesel fuel onto the dirt and asphalt parking area. The amount of diesel released is unknown but can reasonably be estimated between 10-30 gallons. Photographs taken during cleanup activities are included as **Attachment 1**.

EPSVT responded to the release the morning of March 27, 2018 at the request of the Town and met with personnel from the Windham Town Garage. The released diesel spread from the front of the AST to the west to Windham Town Hill Road and then traveled southward along the eastern road shoulder. The spill extended approximately 150 feet from the AST to its terminus. Diesel staining was noted to be two feet across at its widest location. The staining quickly narrowed as it progressed along the side of the road. Contaminated soils were excavated by P&L excavation (PL) of Chester, VT and temporarily stockpiled on site at the WTG facility. EPSVT utilized a properly calibrated photoionization detector (PID) to screen soils throughout the excavation process. PID readings as high as 180 parts per million (PPM) were noted. PID readings of all sidewalls and the bottom of the excavation were noted to be 0.0 ppm at the end of site excavation work. The excavation was 2 feet at its deepest location and typically ranged between 6-12 inches. The excavation was approximately 3 feet wide along the roadside.

A total of 14.66 tons of contmainted soil was temprarily stockpiled on site and subsequently transported off-site on March 28, 2018. The shipping documentation is included as **Attachment** 2.

No surface waters or groundwater were impacted or encountered during spill response activities. It is our opinion that no sensitive receptors are threatened by this release as the spill has been completely remediated.

2.0 Conclusions

Based on the available data, the following conclusions are provided:

• An operator error at the diesel pump system resulted in the release of an estimated 10-30 gallons of diesel fuel onto the parking lot which migrated over the surface to the roadside:

- A total of 14.66 tons of contaminated soil was excavated and shipped to ESMI in Loudon, NH for thermal destruction;
- The release has been successfully mitigated and sensitive receptors are not at risk from the release of diesel fuel.

3.0 Recommendations

EPSVT offers the following recommendations:

No further work is necessary or warranted related to the release of diesel fuel at the site.
 EPSVT recommends closing Spill 2018WMD110.




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






