

Windham Community Organization
June 27, 2018
Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:08 p.m. In attendance were Mary Boyer, Pat Cherry, Joyce Cumming, Kathy Jungermann, Ellen McDuffie and Carolyn Partridge.

Mary announced that the solar project proposed for the property adjacent to the cemetery was canceled as of this morning. Brief discussion followed.

Motion by Carolyn Partridge to accept minutes of May 30, 2018 meeting passed by unanimous vote.

In Cindy's absence, Ellen presented the Treasurer's report. Balance on May 30 was \$4,495.48. Income totaled \$695.00; expenses totaled \$123.51; ending balance as of June 22, 2018 was \$5,066.97.

Committee Reports:

- Good Neighbors – the intake form has not yet been located; Mary will look to see if she has one. Otherwise, a new form will be created based on that utilized by Neighborhood Connections. Ellen suggested a review of the Good Neighbors Committee Procedural Guidelines. The intent of the guidelines was to empower the committee without limiting its ability. Revisions were suggested to clarify some areas of the guidelines; further discussion/action on the procedural guidelines was tabled. The MOU with Neighborhood Connections was distributed; discussion will follow at the next meeting. Ellen also noted the need to update the WCO By-Laws. Joyce did not have anything to report at this time on the need for possible assistance mentioned at the last meeting.
- News and Notes – Ellen reported a delay in getting the issue to the printer. Peter Chamberlain will no longer advertise and Dan Field moved to New Hampshire. Joe Breznick will begin advertising. Discussion followed on possible new ads, such as Tater Hill. Ellen shared a letter to the editor received from the Hoovers. Following brief discussion on the N&N editorial policy, it was determined that the letter would be more appropriate for a local newspaper.

Old Business:

- Thank you letters – Kathy sent a thank you to Jack for sharing his Camp Keewaydin experience at the May meeting. Once the database is updated, Cindy will share the list with Kathy who will send thank-you letters as needed.
- Chicken BBQ, July 14 – In Imme's absence, Kathy passed around the sign-up sheet noting the shortage in a few items needed, i.e., potato salad and corn muffins/cornbread. Raffle items must be received prior to noon on the 14th. Volunteers are also needed to help set up at 9 a.m. and help with salad and strawberry prep at 10 a.m. on the 14th.
- Chocolate Fest, August 6 – Carolyn explained a conflict in her schedule; Pat agreed to represent Neighborhood Connections at the event. Kathy and Joyce will staff the WCO table. Ellen will be away. Claudia Holmes may not be able to attend but may be able to provide baked goods. Motion by Joyce Cumming to reimburse Claudia Holmes up to \$50 for baking supplies was approved by unanimous vote. Ellen will call Claudia. Additional baked goods will be solicited

from community members. Volunteers should arrive at the Landgrove Inn by 4 to 4:30 p.m. on Aug. 6.

- Luncheon – a date for a second WCO luncheon has not yet been determined. Based on summer plans, i.e., chicken BBQ, chocolate fest, vacation schedules, etc., it was agreed to postpone a luncheon until fall.
