Dear MOLLIE WRIGHT,

The Board of Civil Authority has not been able to determine whether you are still a resident and otherwise eligible to vote in WINDHAM. If you continue to reside here, you must complete the enclosed sworn statement of residency including a legal street address or physical description of the place you reside within our municipality and return this form to the clerk. If you do not return the enclosed form, you will be required to sign a sworn affidavit of domicile before you are allowed to vote either at the polling place or before you receive an early absentee ballot.

For the purpose of voting, the Vermont statutes provide the following definition of residency: A "resident" is "a person who is domiciled in the town as evidenced by an intent to maintain a principal dwelling place in the town indefinitely and to return there if temporarily absent, coupled with an act or acts consistent with that intent. If a person removes to another town with the intention of remaining there indefinitely, that person shall be considered to have lost residence in the town in which the person originally resided even though the person intends to return at some future time." 17 V.S.A. §2122(b).

If you no longer reside in WINDHAM, please check the appropriate box, sign the form and return it to the clerk so that we can remove your name from the voter checklist. You can also complete your response by going to the My Voter Page (https://mvp.vermont.gov). You will login with your first name, last name, town of residence as per your registration, date of birth and VT drivers license number or if you do not have a VT DL then the last four #'s of you social security number.

If you have established residency in another municipality, you may register to vote by registering online (https://olvr.vermont.gov), calling the clerk's office in that municipality to request that a voter registration form be mailed to you or you may visit the clerk's office and apply in person. When you apply for a driver's license or change your address at the Department of Motor Vehicles your information will be sent to the Secretary of State for voter registration purposes unless you opt out by checking a box on the form that says you decline. In addition, voter registration is available through the Department of Social Welfare, the Department of Health (WIC), the Department of Aging & Disabilities and the Department of Mental Health.
