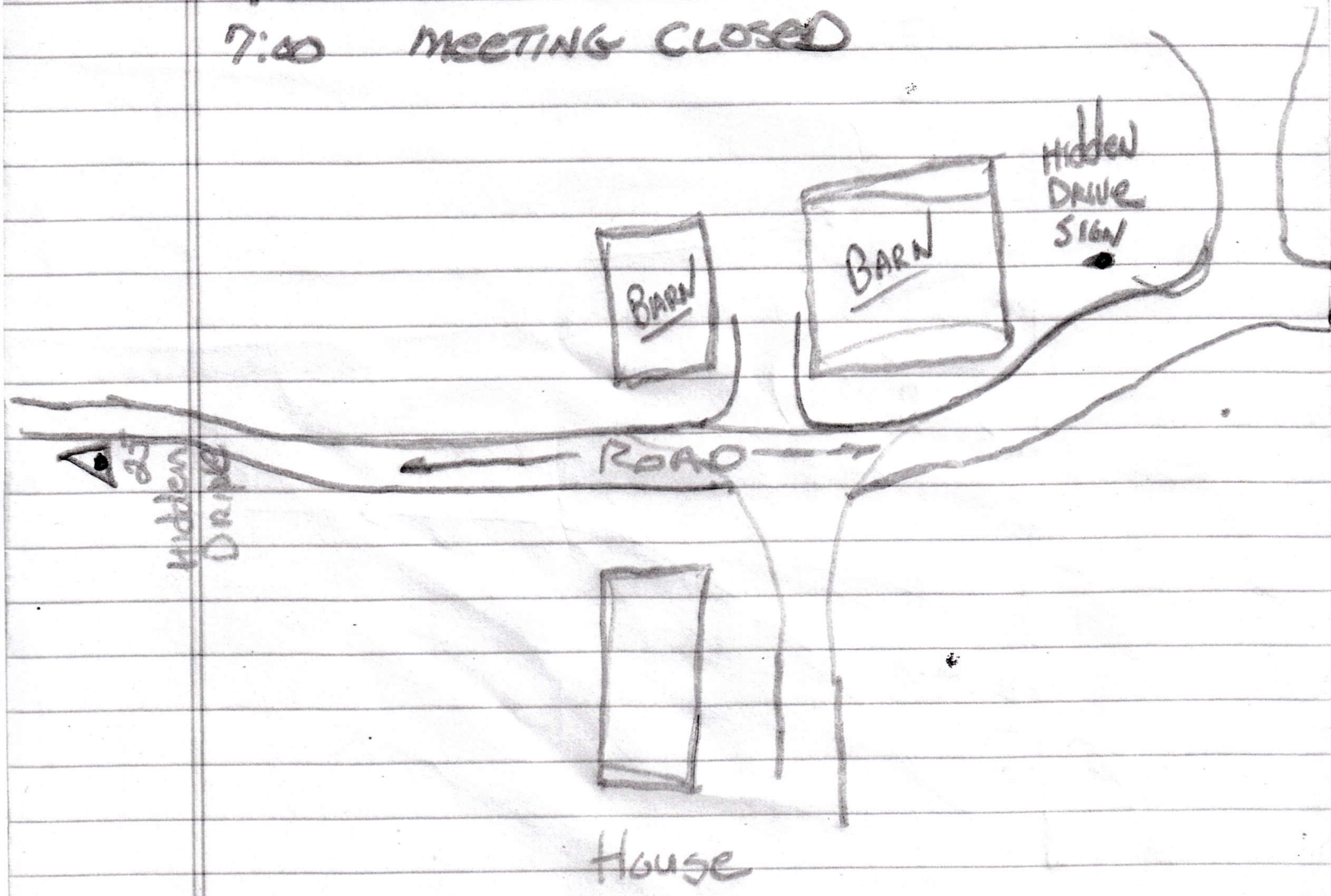

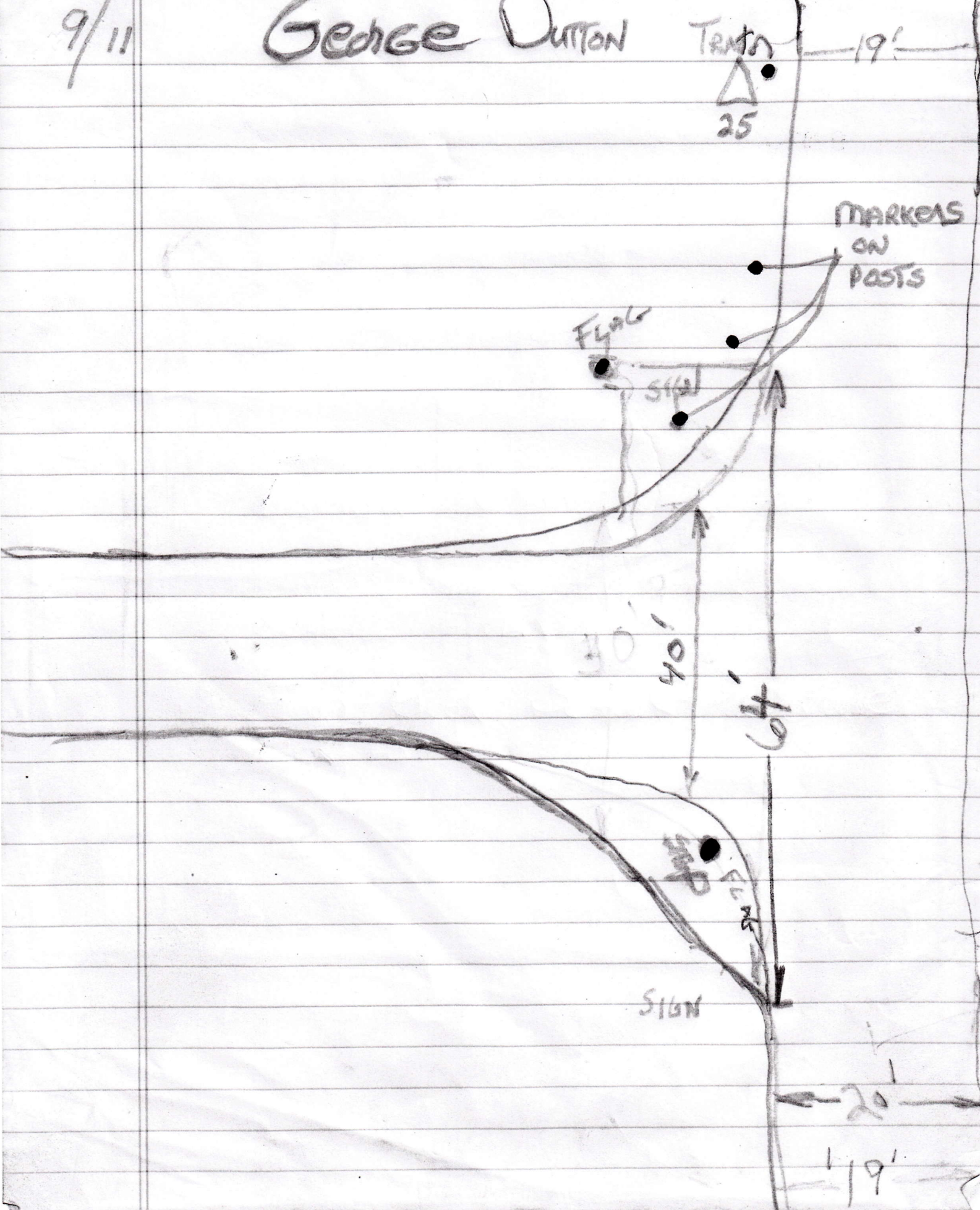

Dear Town of Windham,

I have a home at 1566 West Windham Road and am writing this letter to express my concern regarding the regrading and plowing of West Windham Road in front of my house. The town road crew has been encroaching on the land in front of the house.

After Hurricane Irene the town needed to replace the culvert on Toad Road. At this time Rodney who was then the Road Commissioner, informed me that the intersection between West Windham Road and Toad Road was going to be reconfigured. He said the road needed to be downsized because of a state requirement that intersections of this type had to be perpendicular to force cars to slow down before proceeding. When the culvert was replaced the road was then changed to meet this requirement. The change was effective in slowing down the traffic. I own property on both sides of the road and had the land in front of my house graded and seeded. In the last 2 years the road crew has been widening the road substantially and the speed of the traffic is increasing at a steady pace. When the road was graded a couple of weeks ago they actually moved a large rock on my property about 4 feet into the front yard.

I realize that the road crew has to be able to grade and plow the road. Moving things on my property to widen the road I feel is not acceptable without contacting me prior to doing the work and the property was damaged in the process. I am concerned that the road will not be in compliance with the state requirement and the speed of traffic will become a problem soon.
