**Treasurer's Report:**

Cindy Kehoe presented the annual report for the April 1, 2020 - March 31, 2021.

The beginning balance on April 1, 2020 was \$2644.92.

Income for WCO was \$1600.00

Income for New and Notes was \$4332.00

Expenses for WCO were \$4297.28

Expenses for News and Notes were \$1484.52

Balance as of March 31, 2021 was \$2795.12

Cindy presented Treasurer Report for April 1, 2021-September 28, 2021

The beginning balance on April 1, 2021 was \$2795.12

Income for WCO was \$500.00

Income for News and Notes was \$4617.00

Expenses for WCO were \$215.00

Expenses for News and Notes were \$838.96

Balance as of September 28, 2021 was \$6858.16

Discussion was held re: advertisers update in Windham News and Notes and when the advertising money is due, and keeping the number of advertisers small (6 or 7) to allow for more content.

**Committee Reports:**

Good Neighbors Report- A request was made to WCO for funds for damage caused to tires by gravel on the road. Pat Cherry will reach out to the resident involved in this request which came through the Select Board for reimbursement for new tires due to gravel on the road that caused flat tires. Resident requested assistance with said expense.

News and Notes- The next meeting for the News and Notes will be on 10/5/21 at 3:30 . The deadline for articles is 10/18/21. Hoping to have the copy out by 11/1/21.

Ellen spoke about an article that Michael Pelton would like to write for the New and Notes. The article will focus on building community. As it is a long piece it was suggested that he edit it down to better fit in the News and Notes.

**Old Business:**

WCO sponsored a very successful Ice Cream Social to benefit the Town Meeting House Committee . Donations of \$388 were made as well as an additional \$180 from the 50/50 raffle in which the winner donated their winnings back to the Committee. The total expenses were \$37. A balance of \$351 that the Town of Windham Meeting House Committee voted to put in petty cash. The \$180 from the 50/50 was submitted to the Windham Town Treasurer.
