Energy Committee Minutes 4/21/22

The minutes from the March 17, 2022 meeting were unanimously adopted. Moved by Vance, seconded by Michael.

Vance and Bill volunteered to measure windows again for Window Dressers customers. Bill will be out of the country much of September. Therefore, the committee expressed a preference for having our community-build in late October or early November. Bill will check with Jessica Williams to see how much lead time Window Dressers will need between receiving measurements from us and getting kits to us to build the inserts.

We discussed how to begin publicizing next fall's community-build. We will put articles in the *Windham News & Notes*. Bill will check with Ellen McDuffie about the next deadline. Dawn will mention this at the WCO meeting next Wednesday. The Meeting House Committee is sponsoring a tag sale on Memorial Day, which is an opportunity for us to spread the word.

The rest of the meeting was spent analyzing potential community solar sites in Windham, using the map Ian Lund developed and the criteria spreadsheet that Bill provided to everyone. We agreed to sort potential sites into three categories: Not viable, Maybe viable and Most viable (i.e. No, Maybe, Yes). We examined ten sites beginning at the southern part of town along Old Cheney Road (including Michael and Mac's current home) and prioritized them. We will continue this process at our next meeting, which is scheduled for May 19th at 4:30 PM.
